The Jessica June Children's Cancer Foundation was started by Sandra Muvdi four years ago after losing her daughter, Jessica, to cancer. The Foundation's mission is to provide assistance with basic human needs to children with cancer in medical and

financial crisis living in South Florida. Muvdi explained, "Most of these children receive government assistance such as Medicaid and Social Security Income, but the families are not able to afford basic necessities. When a child is diagnosed with cancer, he or she requires a full time caregiver. The result is the elimination of the income of one parent, often the only parent. Providing financial assistance becomes vital to the continued survival of these children while they receive cancer treatment."

The event's proceeds will benefit local children in need fighting cancer in the community. General admission is \$50 in advance, \$60 at the door, which includes two complimentary cocktails, Blue Martini samples, hors d'oeuvres, live entertainment, a silent auction and two raffle tickets for a chance to win three travel package prizes. Post-event party at Spirits nightclub admission is \$10 in advance, \$20 at the door.
