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Alejandro Lopez is a 17 y/o young man from Ecuador, who traveled from his native country last year with his mother seeking specialized medical care for Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia. The Jessica June Children's Cancer Foundation assisted Alejandro and his family earlier this year and that, I would like to applaud all of you and thank y u for your generous support!

Alejandro underwent a long awaited bone marrow transplant two weeks ago and is presently admitted in the Pediatric Bone Marrow Transplant unit at Jackson Memorial Holtz Children's Hospital. Alejandro's parents are now lodged at the Ronald McDonald House. This hospitalization is projected to be a prolonged one and, even after hospital discharge, Alejandro will continue to need very close and intensive outpatient monitoring for an extended period of time.

As you can well appreciate, Alejandro's disease has taken a huge financial toll on his parents, having to basically uproot themselves from their country, family, their jobs, etc. Alejandro's father is planning to return to his job in Ecuador shortly, leaving Alejandro's mother here by herself to care for Alenjandro. I ask JJCCF to please consider Alejandro for your Advocacy Program (Participation Agreement form is attached), as expenses of all kind continue to pile up and the family is in continued dire need of any assistance that any one of your potential contributors on your website can offer them.
