I am writing to you regarding our patient, Faith Buckner. Faith is a 7 year old little girl who was diagnosed with a brain tumor in November of 2017. She had surgery to remove the tumor shortly after her diagnosis. As a result, the tumor affected her vision. She is permanently blind in her right eye, also leaving the left eye with some vision loss. Faith's medical regimens have consisted of chemotherapy, radiation, and most recent stem cell recovery.

Grandmother, Ms. Consuelo Hoo, is currently unemployed at present due to the frequency of hospitalizations and follow-up clinic visits at University of Miami alex's place. She faces the challenges of still maintaining her household, as well as, being there for her 12 year old daughter, whom continues to attend school and maintain good grades. Ms. Hoo has some family help with her older daughter while she focuses on Faith's health while she is hospitalized and at her follow-up medical visits.

Any financial assistance at this time would be very helpful to Faith and her family at this time, as she receives her medical treatment to help save her life.
