Since her diagnosis, she has undergone countless rounds of chemotherapy, faced two relapses and endured two bone marrow transplants. Arya lives over 2 hours away from our hospital and the family has difficulty finding the gas money to come for her treatments. They also need help with basic necessities like food and medications for Arya.
